

Painty Butterfly

Audience

Designed for all ages.

Materials Needed

- White Cardstock
- Paint
- Newspaper (Table cover)
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Holepunch
- Yarn

Length of Activity

10-15 minutes plus dry time!


Procedure

- 1. Fold a piece of cardstock in half.
- 2. Draw half of a butterfly shape with the center of the butterfly being along the folded edge.
- 3. Cut out your butterfly shape keeping the cardstock folded.





- 4. Cover your worktable with newspaper. Also, lay out newspaper where you are going to place your butterfly to dry.
- 5. Open your paper butterfly and lay flat.



- 6. Drip paint onto one side of your butterfly. Use a little more than you think you should!
- 7. Fold the non-painted side of butterfly over the paint.
- 8. Squeeze the paint from the center fold of your butterfly out towards the edges. The paint will come out from in between the edges.



- 9. Carefully, unfold your butterfly.
- 10. Lay flat to dry completely.
- 11. Once dry, punch a hole near the top of the butterfly. Thread a piece of yarn through the hole and tie in a knot for a hanger.
- 12. Hang up your creation and enjoy!
