

Toucan Stained Glass

Materials Needed

- Construction Paper
 - Background Paper
 - o Black Paper
 - Paper Scraps
- Colored Tissue Paper
- Yarn
- Hole Punch
- Scissors
- Glue
- Pencil

Length of Activity

20-30 minutes


Procedure

- 1. Hold your background sheet of construction paper with the long sides at the top and bottom.
- 2. Sketch a large toucan beak shape on the paper.
- 3. Cut out the beak without cutting through the sides of the paper.





4. Cut out a large half circle from the black construction paper.



- 5. Glue the black half circle along the edge of your background sheet. The half circle will overlap the beak hole a little bit.
- 6. Cut an eye from your scrap construction paper and glue to the black half circle.
- 7. Cut long strips of tissue paper.



- 8. Flip over to the back side of your project.
- 9. Glue the long strips over the beak hole. Use as many strips as it takes to completely fill the entire opening.



10. Hole punch 2 hole along to the top of your project. 11. String yarn through the holes and hang up in a window!
