All plants were grown from seed or taken as cuttings by our Horticulture staff. Some plants may have limited availability.

MILKWEEDS



BROADLEAF MILKWEED

(Asclepias latifolia)

SIZE: Up to 3 ft tall

WATERING: Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers infertile, dry, sandy soil.

NOTES: Perennial, native species. Monarch and butterfly host species. Adapted to drier soils and has large, cabbage like leaves.



BUTTERFLY MILKWEED

(Asclepias tuberosa)

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATERING: Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Perennial, native species. Monarch and butterfly host species. Lower and mounding habit with orange flowers.



COMMON MILKWEED

Asclepias syriaca

SIZE: 3-5 ft tall

WATERING: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Adapted to most soil types.

NOTES: Perennial, native species. Monarch and butterfly host species. Adaptable to many environments.



PRAIRIE MILKWEED

Asclepias sullivantii

SIZE: Up to 3 ft tall

WATERING: Moderate. Prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Adapted to most soil types.

NOTES: Perennial, native species. Monarch and butterfly host species. Has bright pink, fragrant flowers, and can withstand more moist areas than other milkweeds.



SHOWY MILKWEED

Asclepias speciosa

SIZE: 3-5 ft tall

WATERING: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Perennial, native species. Monarch and butterfly host species. Taller, upright growth habit and tolerance for drier soils.



SWAMP MILKWEED

Asclepias incarnata

SIZE: 3-5 ft tall

WATERING: Moderate to heavy, prefers moist to wet soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers wet to moist soil.

NOTES: Perennial, native species. Monarch and butterfly host species. Great for rain gardens or areas that stay moist to wet.

PERENNIALS



BLUE STAR AMSONIA

Amsonia tabernaemontana

SIZE: Up to 3 ft tall

WATERING: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Adapted to most soil types, does best in consistently moist soil.

NOTES: Native species. A milkweed relative with blue flowers, it also serves as butterfly host species. Thrives in heat, just do not let the soil dry out completely.



PURPLE CONEFLOWER

Echinacea purpurea

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall

WATERING: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Hardy plants will thrive through hot weather. Typically, plants will not flower in its first year from seed but once established it is a long-lived plant.



PALE PURPLE CONEFLOWER

Echinacea pallida

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall

WATERING: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Hardy plants will thrive through hot weather. Flowers have long, skinny petals that point downward.



BLACK-EYED SUSAN

Rudbeckia hirta

SIZE: Up to 2 ft tall

WATERING: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Short lived perennial and will self-seed. Thrives through heat.



GLORIOSA DAISY

Rudbeckia gloriosa

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATERING: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Like the Black-Eyed Susan, but a larger plant with flowers having much longer petals. Thrives through heat.



GIANT CONEFLOWER

Rudbeckia maxima

SIZE: plant 2-3 ft, flowers up to 6 ft tall

WATERING: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Hardy plants will thrive through hot weather. Flower stalks grow to 6 or more ft tall!



INDIAN BLANKET (SELF-SEEDING ANNUAL)

Gaillardia aristata

SIZE: Up to 2 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Hardy plants will thrive through hot weather. Will self-seed in garden. Great for meadows or bright garden borders.



BLANKET FLOWER (PERENNIAL)

Gaillardia pulchella

SIZE: Up to 2 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Hardy plants will thrive through hot weather. Will self-seed in garden. Oklahoma State Wildflower.



LONG HEADED CONEFLOWER

Ratibida columnifera

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

Water: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Hardy plants will thrive through hot weather.



AZURE ANCHUSA 'BLUE ANGEL'

Anchusa azurea

SIZE: 2-4 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, rich soil.

NOTES: Will self-seed in garden. Plants have the most incredible blue flowers!



BLUE FALSE INDIGO

Baptista australis

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Once established, very drought tolerant and a long-lived perennial. FEW AVAILABLE!



BLUE PITCHER SAGE

Salvia azurea

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soils.

NOTES: Native species. Hardy plants will thrive through hot weather. Beautiful blue flowers with fragrant leaves.



CUP PLANT

Silphium perfoliatum

SIZE: 6-8 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Grows very tall in one year so it is great at the back of the garden. Leaves create a cup around the stem holding water for insects, birds, and other animals.



LANCELEAF COREOPSIS

Coreopsis lanceolata

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. An adaptable, long-lived plant that is very easy to grow.



LEADPLANT

Amorpha canescens

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Host to butterflies and important pollinator species. Beautiful flowers on a long lived, drought tolerant perennial.



PINCUSHION FLOWER 'BLACK KNIGHT'

Scabiosa atropurpurea

SIZE: Up to 3 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, rich soils.

NOTES: Cut off dead flowers to encourage more to grow. Very cold hardy and will produce flowers late into Fall.



RATTLESNAKE MASTER

Eryngium leavenworthii

SIZE: 4-6 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Taller perennial with Yucca-like leaves and white, spiky flowers. Once dry, shaking the flowers creates a rattle sound like a rattlesnake, giving the plant its name.



ROUNDHEAD LESPEDEZA

Lespedeza capitata

SIZE: 3-5 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Has interesting green flowers, deep roots and is a long-lived perennial once established.



RUSSELL'S LUPINE

Lupinus polyphyllus

SIZE: 2-4 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, rich soil.

NOTES: Prefers cooler, moist conditions so plant it to receive afternoon shade. Typically, will flower in its second year grown from seed.



SCARLET FLAX

Linum grandiflorum

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Intense red flowers on smaller, mounding plants. It has a long blooming period from late spring into fall months making it an important pollinator plant.

WILD SENNA

Senna marilandrica

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Common in local woodland areas, it will prefer shaded margins of gardens. FEW AVAILABLE!



WESTERN YARROW

Achillea occidentalis

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Common in area meadows and easy to grow. Very drought tolerant and an important pollinator plant. Will self-seed in the garden.





YARROW 'PARKERS YELLOW'

Achillea millefolium

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining soils, including dry, sandy soils.

NOTES: Bright yellow flowers with silvery foliage. Great border plant and drought tolerant.



YARROW 'CERISE QUEEN'

Achillea millefolium

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining soils, including dry, sandy soils.

NOTES: Rose colored flowers with silvery foliage. Great border plant and drought tolerant.



HOLLYHOCK (BIENNIAL)

Alcea rosea

3 VARIETIES AVAILABLE:

Black as Night | Double Yellow | Double Violet

SIZE: plant 2-3 ft, flowers 6-8 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, rich soil.

NOTES: A favorite statement plant! Will bloom in their second year from seed and grow flower spikes 6-8 ft tall.



SCARLET ROSE MALLOW 'TEXAS STAR'

Hibiscus coccineus

SIZE: 5-6 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, rich soil.

NOTES: Native species. A favorite to thrive in heat! Grows tall in one year and produces beautiful red Hibiscus flowers.



ZEBRINA MALLOW

Malva sylvestris

SIZE: 2-4 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: Long bloom time and easy to grow. Tolerates extreme heat and cold temperatures well. Not commonly found in ornamental nurseries but a truly amazing perennial plant.



ZEBRINA MALLOW VAR. MAURITIANA

Malva sylvestris var. mauritiana

SIZE: 2-4 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: Similar in habit and growth to the Zebra mallow but with a different color of flower.

NATIVE GRASSES



BLUE GRAMA

Bouteloua gracilis

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, drier soils.

NOTES: Native species. Important species of short grass prairies. Long-lived short bunching grass with feathery seed heads.



INDIAN GRASS

Sorghastrum nutans

SIZE: 4-5 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Important species for mixed and tall grass prairies. Long-lived taller grass with wide leaves that will dry a dark, golden color in the Fall.



LITTLE BLUESTEM

Schizachyrium scoparium

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types.

NOTES: Native species. Important species for mixed and tall grass prairies. Long-lived grass of medium height with thin leaves that dry to a beautiful russet red color in the Fall.



SHEEP FESCUE

Festuca ovina

SIZE: Up to 1 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, including dry, sandy soil types. Great at reclaiming disturbed soil.

NOTES: Native species. Low growing, bunching grass with fine leaves. Great as a ground cover or adding texture to garden borders.

ANNUALS



PURPLE PORTERWEED

Stachytarpheta frantzii

SIZE: 4-6 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: These plants grow well in the heat as an annual. Long spikes covered in small purple flowers are a favorite of butterflies and especially hummingbirds! They grow larger so at great at the back or middle of a garden space.



BLUE DWARF PORTERWEED

Stachytarpheta cayenensis

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall, 3-4 ft wide

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: These plants grow well in the heat as an annual. They grow along the ground in a mounding habit but are covered with spikes of small, blue flowers that are also relished by butterflies and hummingbirds alike!



COTTON PLANT

Gossypium herbaceum

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Low. Drought tolerant, water when plants are young and in hot, dry weather.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers any well-draining soils, including dry, sandy soils.

NOTES: Cotton plants thrive in heat and are beautiful members of the Hibiscus family. They make white flowers a few inches across that later grow into a seed pod full of cotton fibers.



HOPI RED DYE AMARANTH

Amaranth cruentus

SIZE: 4-6 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: A tall plant with striking burgundy foliage and flowers. It is drought tolerant, and the entire plant is edible and very nutritious.



LOVE LIES BLEEDING AMARANTH

Amaranth caudatus

SIZE: 3-5 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: This amaranth variety has its long, red flower spikes hanging downward against the bright green plant. It is an interesting addition to any garden space.



MEXICAN SUNFLOWER 'SUNDANCE'

Tithonia rotundiflora

SIZE: 4-8 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers nutrient poor soils.

NOTES: A sunflower relative, this plant thrives in heat and sun. It does not like nutrient rich soil that tends to make it grow too fast, instead prune it back during the year to promote bushier growth and create lots of blooms!



MOONFLOWER VINE

Ipomoea alba

SIZE: Vine up to 15-20 ft long

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient poor soils.

NOTES: A beautiful morning glory relative with large white flowers that open at night. Great to grow on a trellis or fence and it can get large!



MUSK MALLOW AKA ORNAMENTAL OKRA

Abelmoschus moschatus

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: This plant could potentially survive the winter and live as a short-lived perennial. It has creamy yellow Hibiscus flowers and dark green foliage.

CULINARY & SPECIALTY HERBS



ASHWAGANDA 'VEDIC TYPE'

Withania somnifera

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: This plant is a tomato relative grown in India for its medicinal root. It is a beautiful plant and produces small red berries each year allowing you to save its seeds easily. Washed roots are fragrant like gardenias or flowers and harvestable after one year.



BORAGE

Borago officinalis

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: This plant is bristly but is an incredible plant in the garden! It makes edible blue flowers that taste like cucumbers and planted around other crops will increase the sugar content of their fruits like tomatoes, carrots, etc.



WILD BERGAMOT

Monarda fistulosa

SIZE: 2-4 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: A long lived perennial is grown to be used as a tea among other uses. Cut off dead flowers throughout the season to promote more to grow. Excellent pollinator species and a favorite of bees!



BRONZE FENNEL

Foeniculum vulgare

SIZE: 5-6 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Prefers well-draining, nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: This plant is grown for its edible bulb but is an important pollinator host plant for Swallowtail and other butterfly species. It has darker foliage, is covered in large, flat flowers, and is a statement in any garden!



LEMON BEE BALM

Monarda citriodora

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drought well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: Similar to Bergamot but a shorter plant and with an intense citrus flavor.



LEMON BASIL 'MRS. BURNS HEIRLOOM'

Ocimum citriodorum

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: A favorite Heirloom variety of Basil and the most intense lemon flavor you can imagine. Plant by tomato plants to help repel hornworms and other pests.



LICORICE ROOT

Glycyrrhiza glabra

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient rich, sandy soils.

NOTES: This plant is the source of true licorice root. It has been used as a medicine for digestive issues for millennia. It is a cold hardy shrub that will grow as a perennial in our area. FEW AVAILABLE!



MARSH MALLOW

Althea officinalis

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient rich, sandy soils.

NOTES: The roots of this plant are the original source of candied marsh mallows. It has a list of medicinal uses and is covered in small 1 to 2 inch white Hibiscus flowers. A great addition to the garden and easy to save its seeds.



YELLOW TOOTHACHE PLANT

Spilanthes oleracea

SIZE: 1-3 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: Pinch and prune plant to promote a bushier growth habit. Small yellow flowers when eaten will briefly make your mouth go numb, giving the plant its name and long history of medicinal use.



TULSI OR HOLY BASIL 'RAMA'

Ocimum tenuiflorum

SIZE: 1-2 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Does well in most soils, prefers any well-draining soil.

NOTES: This basil variety is used for tea instead of cooking. It has a delicious, sweet flavor and is an important plant in Indian Ayurvedic medicine.

HEIRLOOM TOMATOES

Plants were grown from seeds sourced from the Seed Savers Exchange and information about each can also be found through their website.

GENERAL TOMATO CARE

PLANT SIZE:

Bush – plants grow as bushes to 3-6 ft tall. These plants need cages or supports to grow and set fruit.

Cherry – plants grow as vines and grow to 10 ft or more. These plants need a trellis, fence, or a support structure to grow upon.

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient rich soils.



MORTGAGE LIFTER TOMATO

TYPE: Beefsteak tomato, large size

NOTES: Great flavor and productive plant. Will need supports or cages to handle the large fruits as they mature.



GOLD MEDAL TOMATO

TYPE: Beefsteak tomato, medium size

NOTES: Medium sized, bicolor tomato is yellow and red in color with red streaks inside the flesh. Incredibly sweet!

CHEROKEE PURPLE TOMATO

TYPE: Slicing tomato, medium size

NOTES: A maroon tomato with a dark top having a sweet and delicious flavor. A favorite variety!



GREEN ZEBRA TOMATO

TYPE: Slicing tomato, medium size

NOTES: A green and yellow striped tomato that is great eaten fresh.



AMISH PASTE TOMATO

TYPE: Sauce tomato, medium size

NOTES: Roma sized fruits are prized for their sauce and paste making.



LARGE RED CHERRY TOMATO

TYPE: Cherry tomato

NOTES: Very productive plant with quick maturing bunches of small fruits.



WHITE CHERRY TOMATO

TYPE: Cherry tomato

NOTES: Small, white fruits with a sweet, fruity flavor.



CHOCOLATE CHERRY TOMATO

TYPE: Cherry tomato

NOTES: Very productive plant with dark maroon fruits having a sweet flavor.



HEIRLOOM PEPPERS

GENERAL PEPPER CARE

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil. Prefers more nutrient rich soils, so amending with compost throughout the growing season will help.

(Listed MILD to HOT)



MINI CHOCOLATE BELL PEPPER

SIZE: 3-4 ft tall, fruits 2 inches long

NOTES: Maroon, miniature bell peppers only 2 inches long. Originally from an Ohio backyard garden in the 1980's where a bell pepper produced all miniature fruits! Also sourced from Seed Savers Exchange.



AJÍ MANGO PEPPER

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall, fruits 2 inches long

NOTES: From South America, these peppers are medium spicy but with a great fruity finish. Great in salsas.



FISH PEPPER

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall, fruits 3 inches long

NOTES: Unique plant with variegated leaves and medium spicy, striped fruits. Also sourced from Seed Savers Exchange.



AJÍ LIMO 'LEMON DROP' PEPPER

SIZE: 2-3 ft tall, fruits 3 inches long

NOTES: From South America, these peppers are very spicy but with an intensely citrus flavor. Highly productive plants will produce all summer and fall.



JOE'S LONG CAYENNE PEPPER

SIZE: 4-5 ft tall, fruits 10-12 inches long

NOTES: This is an heirloom originally from Italy but grows very spicy, long Cayenne peppers up to 10-12 inches long. Also sourced from Seed Savers Exchange.

TROPICALS & HOUSEPLANTS



BIRD OF PARADISE 'WHITE'

Strelitzia reginae

SIZE: 4-6 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Any well-draining soil but prefers more nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: These plants are divisions from plants in larger pots. They will grow fast this upcoming year with nutrients and plenty of sun. Great container plant that would need to be brought indoors during colder months. Plants available in 1 gallon and 3 gallon pots.



PLUMERIA 'MIXED COLORS'

Plumeria fragipani

SIZE: up to 8-10 feet tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Any well-draining soil but prefers more nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: These plants are cuttings taken from larger plants. They grow quickly and want as much light as you can give them! With more light will come more watering to keep the soil moist. Great container plant that would need to be brought indoors during colder months. Flower colors are white, pink, or orange. Plants available in 1 gallon pots.



REED ORCHID 'ORANGE'

Epidendrum radicans

SIZE: About 2 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate, prefers moist soil but will tolerate drier soil well.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Any well-draining soil. In a container, it would be a mix of bark and cactus mix.

NOTES: Potted plants can be buried in the ground in a garden, then removed in Fall to be kept warm over winter. Performs well in heat with regular watering. Plants in various pot sizes are available.



SPIDER PLANT 'VARIEGATED'

Chlorophytum comosum

SIZE: About 1 ft tall

WATER: Low to moderate. Let soil dry briefly between waterings. Typically watering weekly as a houseplant.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day) to Part Shade (4-6 hours/day)

SOIL: Any well-draining soil. Common potting soil does well.

NOTES: One of the best plants to clean or purify indoor air quality and one of the easiest houseplants to grow. A great addition to any house or beginner plant.



TURNERA AKA BUSH BUTTERCUP

Turnera ulmifolia

SIZE: About 1 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: Native to the Caribbean, this beautiful small plant has bright yellow flowers and is a relative to Passion vines. Great in containers or in garden borders. Easily grown from cuttings and available in 1 gallon pots.



ZEBRA PLANT

Aphelandra squarrosa

SIZE: 4-6 ft tall

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Part Shade (4-6 hours/day). Direct light will burn leaves, so best in indirect light.

SOIL: Any well-draining soil but prefers more nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: FEW AVAILABLE! These plants are cuttings taken from larger plants. They grow quickly and would love amended soil and bright, indirect light. It is a beautiful container plant that would need to be brought indoors during colder months. Plants available in 1 gallon pots.



PAPAYA TREE 'RED MATADOR'

Carica papaya

SIZE: Up to 10+ ft tall, can be kept smaller in containers

WATER: Moderate, prefers moist soil.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: Potted trees grown from seed last year are now about 4 ft tall and beginning to flower. Papaya trees have separate male and female trees, but this variety will make fruit with only one tree. It is a beautiful container plant that would need to be brought indoors during colder months. Can be kept in a container long term by pruning the top to keep the tree shorter in size. Available in 3 gallon pots.



MORINGA TREE

Moringa oleifera

SIZE: Up to 10+ ft tall, can be kept smaller in containers

WATER: Low to moderate. Let soil dry briefly between waterings.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Grows in any well-draining soil and prefers more nutrient rich soils.

NOTES: Truly amazing tree that can be grown in the garden as an annual or in a container that is brought indoors during colder months. Native to arid India, the leaves are incredibly nutritious and high in minerals when eaten raw or dried. It can be pruned routinely to keep the tree smaller in size.

CACTI & SUCCULENTS



CEREUS CACTUS 'SPIRALIS'

Cereus forbesii

SIZE: Up to 5 ft or more tall, slow growing

WATER: Low. Water when soil dries.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Well-draining and nutrient poor. Use cactus mix for containers.

NOTES: FEW AVAILABLE! Cuttings taken last Fall from a larger specimen, now rooted and growing on their own.



PINK DESERT ROSE

Adenium obesum

SIZE: Up to 3 ft tall, slow growing

WATER: Low. Water when soil dries.

SUN: Full Sun (6-8 hours/day)

SOIL: Well-draining and nutrient poor. Use cactus mix for containers.

NOTES: FEW AVAILABLE! Goes dormant in winter and loses its leaves. Needs little to no water in this time but will wake up with more water and light each Spring.
